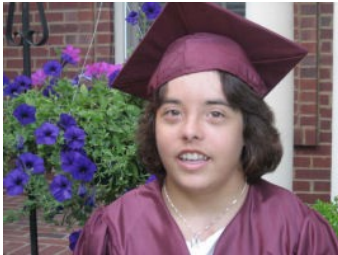

# Postsecondary Inclusion Partnership

## Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008

- Allows students with intellectual disabilities to be eligible for Pell Grants, Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants, and Federal Work-Study Program.
- Authorizes the development and expansion of high-quality, inclusive model comprehensive transition and post-secondary programs.
- Authorizes establishment of a coordinating center for technical assistance, evaluation, outreach and more!



## What is PIP?

**PIP** is a pilot project funded by the KY Council on Developmental Disabilities and implemented by HDI. It is aimed at including students with intellectual and other developmental disabilities in postsecondary education.

In our first year, the project will center on ten students attending or seeking to attend Bluegrass Community and Technical College (BCTC).

In year two, we will expand to serve more students and to offer more choices in colleges and universities.

Working with students, their families, professors and school administrators, PIP teams will create individualized plans to aid academic, extracurricular and social success.
